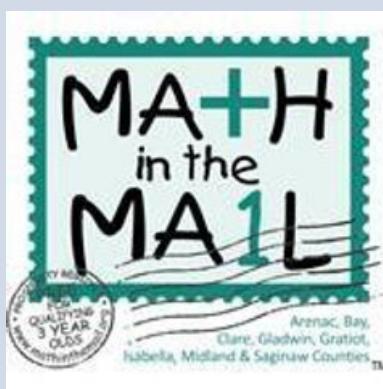

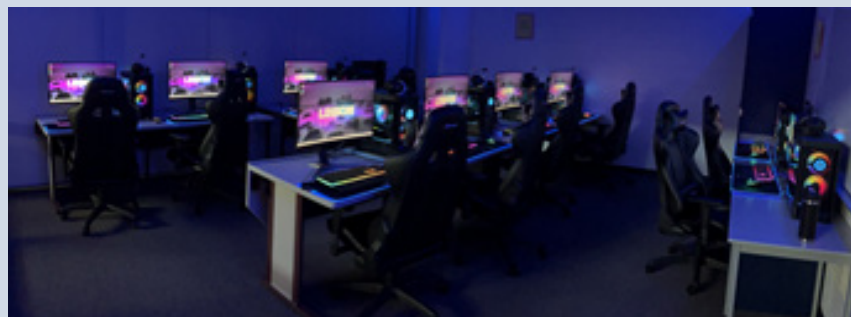
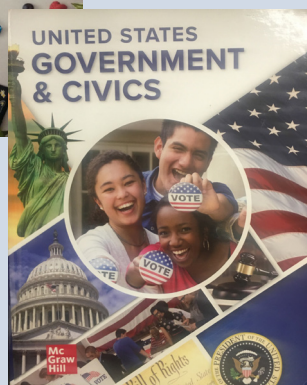
The Tribal Grants Are Appreciated at SSC



Our Standish-Sterling School District would like to say "THANK YOU" to the Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe for their continuous support they show towards our students and our school district. Their donations have greatly improved our schools and our athletic programs and have also supplied the classrooms with educational equipment to help advance the knowledge of our students.

In 2023, the 2% tribal grants have allowed SSC to purchase items or equipment for the following: Central Elementary Copier, Arenac Community Center Roof, Huddle Sports Technology, Wireless Microphone System, E-Sports Equipment, 6-foot Event Tables, High School Ice Machine, Math in the Mail, PAWS Rewards, Benchmark Advanced ELA Elementary K-1 Asmt., Summer Rec Program, New Softball Backstop, Sportstraq GPS Line Marking System, 2-Pad Football Sled, Textbook Purchases, Choir Dress Upgrades, Arenac Community Center Fencing With a Gate, AED Portable Units & Wall Mounted Units, and Illuminate-DNA Student Data System. HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS NEED TO PAY CLASS DUES!

In an effort to eliminate the need for class fundraisers, all high school students pay class dues of \$10 per year. Class dues are used to defray the cost of supplies that each class uses throughout the year. Junior year, the class is responsible for putting on the Prom, and Senior year expenses include extra yearbook pages, Senior breakfast, and graduation decorations and flowers... just to name a few! Senior year is quite an expensive year for parents, so it is recommended that dues be paid in full (\$40) prior to the start of Senior year.

Parents may send in class dues with their student at any time. Remind your child to ask the Class Advisor for a receipt and keep it with your records until graduation!

Many parents make a one payment of \$40, but paying \$10 per year is also welcomed. You may mail a check for dues to the high school, drop off cash payments at the high school office, or send it in with your student. Be sure to note your child's name and graduation year on the check or envelope. Make checks payable to "Standish-Sterling H.S."

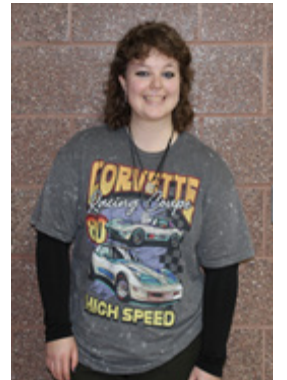

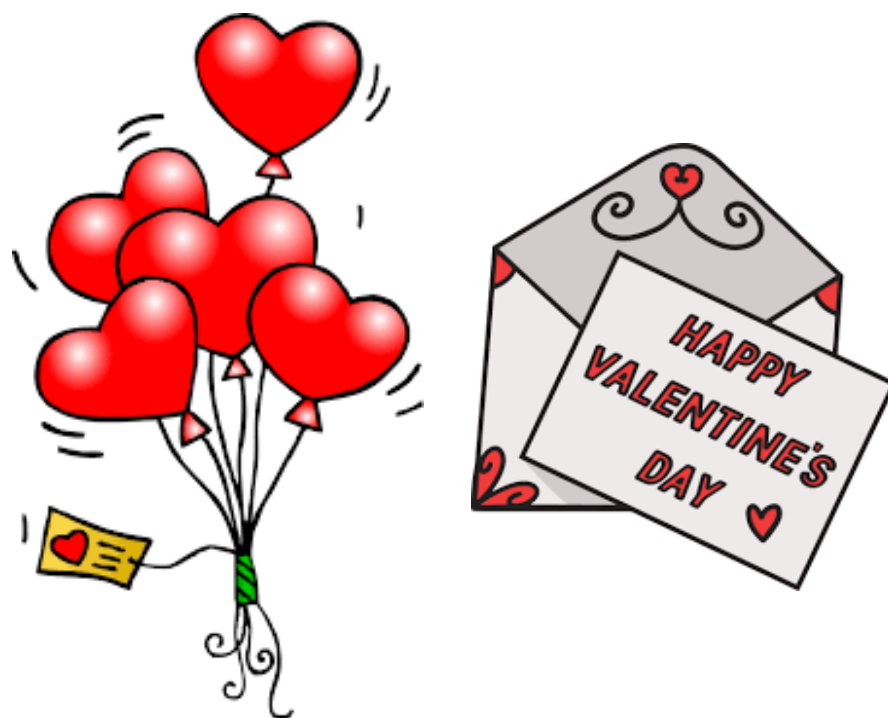

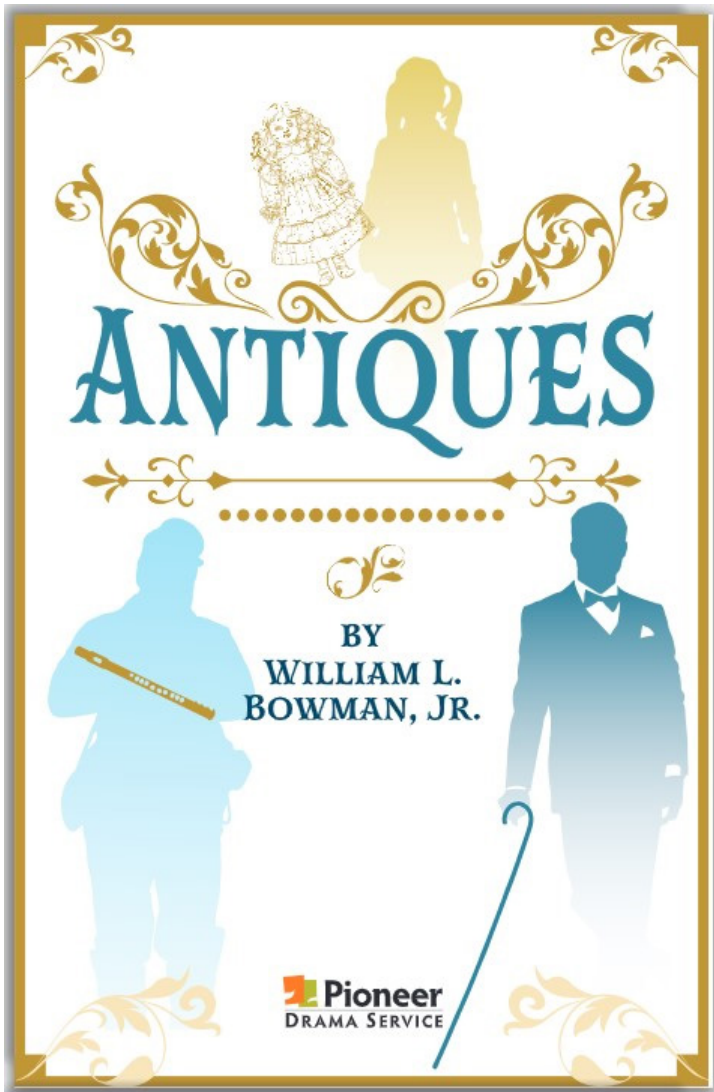
